Items may be taken out of the order presented on the agenda at the discretion of the Chair. Items may be combined for consideration by the Commission at the discretion of the Chair. Items may be pulled or removed from the agenda at any time.

1. **CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL** – Chair, Governor Joe Lombardo
2. **PUBLIC COMMENT**– (Discussion Only) – The first public comment is limited to comments on items on the agenda. No action may be taken upon a matter raised under public comment period unless the matter itself has been specifically included on an agenda as an action item. Public comments may be limited to 3 minutes per person at the discretion of the Chair. Comments will not be restricted based on viewpoint.

3. **APPROVAL OF MINUTES** – (Discussion/For Possible Action) – Chair, Governor Joe Lombardo or Vice Chair, Sheriff Kevin McMahon. The Commission will review and discuss the minutes of the August 8, 2025, Commission meeting. The Commission will determine whether to approve the meeting minutes.
4. **STATEWIDE NATIONAL INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (NIMS) COMPLIANCE REPORT** – (Information Only) – Brett Compston, Chief of the Nevada Office of Emergency Management/ Homeland Security (OEM/HS). The Commission will receive the quarterly report on the statewide adoption of, and compliance with, the NIMS, as required by Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) 239C.310.

5. **COMMISSION MEMBERSHIP CHANGES** – (Discussion Only) – Chair Governor Lombardo or Vice Chair, Sheriff Kevin McMahon. The Chair will introduce a new member of the Commission, Christopher Delzotto, special agent in charge at the FBI.
6. **RECOMMENDATION FOR CREATION OF FUEL RESILIENCY COMMITTEE** – (Discussion/For Possible Action) – Chase McNamara, the Governor’s Natural Resources Policy Advisor, will introduce a proposal on behalf of the Governor to authorize the establishment of a Fuel Resiliency Committee (“Committee”) under the authority of the Commission granted in NRS 239C.170. The Committee is being proposed for the purpose of evaluating vulnerabilities, coordinating preparedness efforts, and recommending measures to secure Nevada’s transportation fuel supply and related infrastructure. The Commission may evaluate the proposal and vote to establish the Committee.
7. **REQUEST TO ALLOW THE FUEL RESILIENCY COMMITTEE TO HOLD CLOSED MEETINGS UNDER NRS 239C.140(2)** – (Discussion/For Possible Action) – Chase McNamara, the Governor’s Natural Resources Policy Advisor, will request that the Commission consider the closure of Fuel Resiliency Committee (“Committee”) meetings under NRS 239C.140(2) when the Committee is receiving a security briefing, discussing procedures for responding to acts of terrorism and related emergencies, and discussing deficiencies in security with respect to public services, public facilities, and infrastructure. The Commission may vote to permit closed meetings of the Committee under the authority granted in NRS 239C.140(2).
8. **LESSONS LEARNED FROM CYBERSECURITY INCIDENT** – (Discussion Only) – Tim Galluzi, Governor’s Technology Office, Chief Information Officer (CIO). Chief Galluzi will share lessons learned in responding to Nevada’s cyber incident, which started in August 2025.
9. **PUBLIC COMMENT**– (Discussion Only) – This public comment period is for any matter that is within the jurisdiction of the public body. No action may be taken upon a matter raised under this public comment period unless the matter itself has been specifically included on an agenda as an action item. Public comments may be limited to 3 minutes per person at the discretion of the Chair. Comments will not be restricted based on viewpoint.

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10. **ADJOURNMENT** – (Discussion/For Possible Action).
