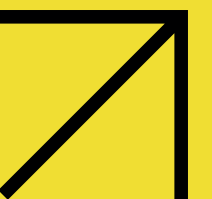
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October 2025 Nevada's Post-Fire Hazard Mitigation Grant Program

Mitigation Funding Available

\$1,285,231.00

Nevada has been approved for three Fire Management Assistance Grant (FMAG) declarations in FY25:

- **FM-5546-NV-Callahan Fire** (Washoe County, declared 11/11/2024) - FUNDED \$1,285, 231.00
- FM-5586-NV -Marie Fire (Washoe County, Pending funding allocation) - To be determined
- FM-5602-NV - Peavine Fire (Washoe County, Pending funding allocation) - To be determined
- Connor Fire (Pending Award Letter from FEMA) - Pending funding allocation) -To be determined

At this time, FEMA Region 9 has allocated funding only for **FM-5546-NV**, with a total of **\$1,285,231.00** available for projects.

Application Deadline for Project Review to NV Mitigation Team: February 27th

Application Deadline: March 30, 2026

Project Prioritization:

The Hazard Mitigation Working Group will rank and vote on applications based on the following priority criteria:

1. **First Priority:** Projects located in the specific area impacted by the fire for which the FMAG was granted
2. **Second Priority:** Projects located within the county where the FMAG occurred (Washoe County)
3. **Third Priority:** All other eligible projects statewide

Important Information for All Applicants:

While we currently have funding allocated only for FM-5546-NV, **we strongly encourage sub-applicants to begin developing and submitting applications for projects related to all three approved FMAGs (FM-5546, FM-5586, and FM-5602).** Projects submitted for the two FMAGs not yet funded (FM-5586 and FM-5602) will be:

- Ranked and evaluated alongside FM-5546 projects
- Waitlisted pending funding allocation from FEMA
- Ready for immediate implementation should additional funds become available



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Cost Share/Match Requirement

HMGP Post-Fire requires a 75% federal and 25% non-federal cost share. The non-federal match can be cash, in-kind contributions, or a combination, but cannot be federal funds or funds already used as a match for another federal award.

Planning Activities Funding

Up to 7% of total HMGP Post-Fire funding can be used for planning activities, which includes hazard mitigation plans and planning-related activities.

FM-5546-NV Allocation:

\$1,285,231.00 in project funding, the breakdown matches:

- Planning Projects: \$89,966 (approximately 7%)
- Initiative Projects (Non-Cost-Effective): \$64,262 (approximately 5%)
- Regular Projects: \$1,131,003 (remaining funds for cost-effective projects)
