1. **CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL** – Co-Chair, Harriett Vegas.
2. **PUBLIC COMMENT**– (Discussion Only) – No action may be taken upon a matter raised under this item of the agenda until the matter itself has been specifically included on the agenda as an item upon which action may be taken. Public comments may be limited to three minutes per person at the discretion of the Co-Chairs. Comments will not be restricted based on viewpoint.

4. **OFFICE OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT (OEM/HS) UPDATES** - (Discussion Only) - Co-Chair Brett Compston will provide the NTECC with an update on Fiscal Year 2025 DHS grants, legislative results, and upcoming events.
5. **UPDATE TO NTECC MEMBERSHIP** – (Discussion Only) – Aaron Thacker, Tribal Coordinator OEM/HS. Mr. Thacker will discuss the recent changes to NTECC membership and request input on the selection of future members from tribes to make a more robust Council.
6. **UPDATE ON TRIBAL HEALTH PREPAREDNESS EFFORTS** – (Discussion Only) – Emily Gould-Monaghan, Public Health Preparedness Program. Ms. Monaghan will update the NTECC on the Division of Public and Behavioral Health’s Health Preparedness efforts related to the overall program, staffing, plan review and revision, and a 5-year strategic plan review.
7. **UPDATE ON NEVADA CYBER EVENT-** (Discussion Only) – Christopher Daniels and

John Fansler, OEM/HS. Mr. Daniels and Mr. Fansler will discuss the Nevada Cyber event and how it impacted OEM/HS operations.

8. **UPDATE FROM THE INTER-TRIBAL COUNCIL OF NEVADA (ITCN)** - (Discussion Only) – Clifford Banuelos, Tribal-State Environmental Liaison for ITCN. Mr. Banuelos will provide the NTECC with an update of ITCN activities related to the support of Tribal emergency management and public health preparedness.
9. **UPDATE FROM NEVADA DEPARTMENT OF NATIVE AMERICAN AFFAIRS (DNAA)** - (Discussion Only) - Stacey Montooth. Ms. Montooth will provide NTECC with an update of DNAA activities related to the support of Tribal emergency management and public health preparedness.

The NTECC will also be briefed on the status of current and expected grants.
