



- **Incident Management Assistance Team (IMAT) – State-organized, rapidly deployable, multidisciplinary emergency management team, established pursuant to Nevada Revised Statute 414 that is authorized to supplement, support, or provide Emergency Operations Center (EOC) coordination functions at the local or tribal Authority Having Jurisdiction (AHJ) level.**
  - Such a team is designed to assist local or tribal jurisdictions—**particularly rural and frontier communities that may lack the capacity to staff and operate their own EOCs**—with operational coordination, resource management, and strategic implementation of response and recovery activities in accordance with applicable state and federal emergency management funding programs.
  - IMAT 1 – Comprised of State Agency Personnel only
  - IMAT 2 – Comprised of surge local and tribal personnel (neighbors helping neighbors)
- **Minimum Essential Staffing 9 PAX (Type 3 IMAT according to FEMA NQS):**
  - EOC Manager/IMAT Leader (1)
    - Command Staff
      - PIO (1)
      - LNO (1)
      - SFO (1)
    - General Staff
      - OSC (1)
      - PSC (1)
      - LSC (1)
        - COMML (1)
      - FSC (1)
  - **NOTE:** IMAT provides the overhead, and then source additional personnel resources as needed through the AHJ, mutual aid, volunteers, and contractors
