1. **CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL** – Chair, Brett Compston, State Administrative Agent (SAA) and Vice-Chair, Deputy Chief Brian O'Neal, Urban Area Administrator (UAA).
2. **PUBLIC COMMENT**– (Discussion Only) – No action may be taken upon a matter raised under this item of the agenda until the matter itself has been specifically included on the agenda as an item upon which action may be taken. Public comments may be limited to 3 minutes per person at the discretion of the Chair. Comments will not be restricted based on viewpoint.

4. **HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT PROGRAM DEFINITIONS**– (Discussion/ For Possible Action) – Chair Brett Compston, Office of Emergency Management (OEM), and Vice-Chair Brian O'Neal, Clark County Fire Department (CCFD). The Committee will discuss and may vote to recommend definitions related to the Homeland Security Grant Program project classifications, specifically "maintain," "enhance," and "new."
5. **GRANT STATUS REPORT** – (Discussion Only) – Shea Slone, OEM Preparedness Grants Supervisor. The Committee will receive quarterly grant reports, which will outline the spending status on Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG), Homeland Security Grant Program (HSGP), and Nonprofit Security Grant Program (NSGP) and State and Local Cybersecurity Grant Program (SLCGP).

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6. **2025 GRANTS UPDATES** – (Discussion Only) – Susan Coyote, OEM Grants Chief. The Committee will receive updates on the current status of the federal fiscal year 2025 Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG), Homeland Security Grant Program (HSGP), and Nonprofit Security Grant Program (NSGP), State and Local Cybersecurity Grant Program (SLCGP), and prior years of the Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities (BRIC) grant program.
