SUBJECT: National Incident Management System (NIMS) 2026 Quarter 1 Report

Note: Due to the federal shutdown, reporting activities for the Independent Study Program are based on the last report that was submitted to the Nevada Office of Emergency Management (OEM) on February 1, 2026.

Purpose: The Commission receives updated information on the first quarterly report for the period from January to March 2026, which details the statewide adoption and compliance with the National Incident Management System (NIMS), as mandated by Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) 239C.310.

Summary: A total of 2,211 students have completed NIMS training facilitated by the OEM. Of these, 1,718 students engaged in independent study courses, while the remaining 493 students participated in consortium courses, including ICS 300/400 and G/Federal offerings.
