SUBJECT: National Incident Management System (NIMS) 2026 Quarter 2 Report

Note: The federal shutdown which ended on April 30 affected enrollment numbers for the month of April.

Purpose: The Commission receives updated information on the second quarterly report for the period from April to June 2026, which details the statewide adoption and compliance with the National Incident Management System (NIMS), as mandated by Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) 239C.310.

Summary: During the reporting period, a total of **6,669 Nevada training records** were documented. This includes **5,536 independent study course completions** across NIMS and other emergency management training topics, as well as **1,133 students** who participated in OEM-sponsored courses, including ICS 300/400, and other State (G courses) and Federal sponsored instructor-led and virtual courses.
