Governor's Committee on Fuel Resiliency Organizational Guidance for Initial Committee Meeting

Dear Members of Governor's Committee on Fuel Resiliency:

Thank you for your willingness to serve on the Governor's Committee on Fuel Resiliency. Nevada's fuel supply is essential to public safety, emergency response, and economic stability. Your collective expertise will play a critical role in identifying vulnerabilities and advancing practical, long-term solutions to strengthen fuel reliability and resilience across the State.

As you convene for your initial meeting, I encourage the committee to organize its work efficiently and collaboratively. To support that effort, I respectfully recommend that the committee consider electing Brett Compston as Chair and Catherine Reheis-Boyd as Vice Chair.

Mr. Compston serves as Administrator of the Nevada Division of Emergency Management and brings extensive experience in statewide preparedness, response coordination, and infrastructure resilience. Ms. Reheis-Boyd brings decades of experience in energy policy, fuel markets, regulatory strategy, and stakeholder engagement. Her expertise in navigating complex, multi-jurisdictional energy issues will be invaluable as the committee evaluates supply chains, infrastructure constraints, and policy options to enhance fuel resiliency for Nevada.

I acknowledge that under NRS 239C.170, the Committee is to select its own chair and vice chair from its membership, and I support the Committee's authority and autonomy in making that decision. That said, together, their complementary experience in emergency management and energy policy would provide steady, informed leadership as the committee develops actionable recommendations for the State.
