Items may be taken out of the order presented on the agenda at the discretion of the Chair. Items may be combined for consideration by the Committee at the discretion of the Chair. Items may be pulled or removed from the agenda at any time.

Please Note: Witnesses wishing to have their complete testimony/handouts included in the permanent record of this meeting should provide a written or electronic copy to the Committee administrative support staff. Minutes of the meeting are produced in a summary format and are not verbatim.

1. **CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL** – Brett Compston, State Administrative Agent (SAA).
2. **PUBLIC COMMENT** – (Discussion Only) – No action may be taken upon a matter raised under this item of the agenda until the matter itself has been specifically included on the agenda as an item upon which action may be taken. Public comments may be limited to 3 minutes per person at the discretion of the Chair. Comments will not be restricted based on viewpoint.

3. **REVIEW OF OPEN MEETING LAW REQUIREMENTS** - (Discussion Only) – Brett Compston, Administrator, Nevada Office of Emergency Management / Homeland Security (OEM/HS), will review basic requirements of the Committee in accordance with the Nevada Open Meeting Law.
4. **INTRODUCTION OF MEMBERS** - (Discussion Only) – Brett Compston, Administrator, OEM/HS, will facilitate introductions of Committee members.
5. **REVIEW OF CHARTER AND GOVERNOR'S GUIDANCE** - (Discussion Only) - Brett Compston, Administrator, OEM/HS, and Chase McNamera, Governor's Policy Advisor on Natural Resources. The Committee will review the direction provided by the Nevada Commission on Homeland Security in regard to the creation of the Committee and its objectives. Additional recommendations from the Governor regarding Committee leadership will be provided to Committee members.
6. **ELECTION OF LEADERSHIP** – (Discussion/For Possible Action) – Brett Compston, Administrator, OEM/HS. The Committee will elect a Chair and Vice Chair for the Committee from the appointed membership.

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7. **DETERMINATION OF WHETHER TO CLOSE THE MEETING** – (Discussion/For Possible Action) – Chair-Elect. The Committee will consider whether to close the meeting pursuant to Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) 239C.140(2) to allow members to receive information related to the security and status of the Nevada fuel environment and system. The Committee members must determine by majority vote that the public disclosure of such matters would be likely to compromise, jeopardize or otherwise threaten the safety of the public.

As mandated by the Nevada Open Meeting Law, no action may be taken by the Commission during a closed session. Except as otherwise provided in NRS 239.0115, all information and materials received or prepared by the Commission during a closed meeting, and all minutes and audiovisual or electronic reproductions of such a meeting, are confidential and not subject to inspection by the general public.

8. **CLOSED SESSION** - (Discussion Only) - Chair-Elect
- **PRESENTATION ON THE NEVADA FUEL ENVIRONMENT AND SYSTEM AND THE RELATED DEFICIENCIES IN SECURITY** – (Discussion Only) – Mr. Gordon Schrepf, Nemequ Analytics, LLC., and Mr. Skip York, DSC Advising, LLC., will provide an overview of the Nevada fuel environment to include regional and national level implications, risks, and opportunities that will affect the Committee in achieving its objectives.
 - **SECURITY BRIEFING FROM INDUSTRY PARTNERS** – (Discussion Only) – The Committee will receive briefings from industry members on the current and potential future state of the fuel environment as specifically related to their company. This will include potential opportunities, risks, and challenges.
9. **DETERMINATION OF WHETHER TO RE-OPEN MEETING** – (Discussion/For Possible Action) – Chair-Elect. The Committee will consider whether to open the meeting to the public.
10. **FUEL ANALYSIS PRODUCT** – (Discussion/For Possible Action) – Chair-Elect. The Committee will discuss options to generate a fuel analysis product evaluating the current fuel environment affecting the State of Nevada, which the Committee could use as a basis for future recommendations from the Committee to the Governor. The Committee will discuss next steps related to achieving the objectives set forth by the Nevada Commission on Homeland Security.
11. **PUBLIC COMMENT** – (Discussion Only) – No action may be taken upon a matter raised under this item of the agenda until the matter itself has been specifically included on the agenda as an item upon which action may be taken. Public comments may be limited to 3 minutes per person at the discretion of the Chair. Comments will not be restricted based on viewpoint.
