## Nevada Office of Emergency Management | NHMWG Ranking Session

### State / Territory Allocation

**\$2.0M total cap**

*\$1.8M porojects +10% / \$200k mgmt. cost*

- Applicant ranks all subapplications #1 to lowest (doing this through NHMWG voting and ranking)
- FEMA funds in rank order until the \$2M cap is reached
- Top-ranked project alone must not exceed \$2M
- Ranked separately form the National Competition (Those not ranked highly will still be eligible for National Competition)

### National Competition

**National Competition**

*Up to \$20M federal share per project*

- Applicant ranks all National sub-applications (doing this through NHMWG voting and ranking)
- FEMA Scores & selects; ranks informs priority order
- Recipient (State) management cost (10%) requested separately - on top, not counted against, the \$2M State Allocation cap
- Ranked separately than the State Allocation

### Building Code Plus -up

**1.0M state cap**

- Applicant ranks Puls-Up subapplications on their own
- FEMA Funds in rank order to the \$1 cap
- Cannot be submitted to National Competition
- Ranked separately from State Allocation & National

Process: Each sub-applicant present 5 min at NHMWG → Working Group votes & ranks within its track → NV OEM finalizes rank order in FEMA GO → Submission to FEMA GO due July 23, 2026
