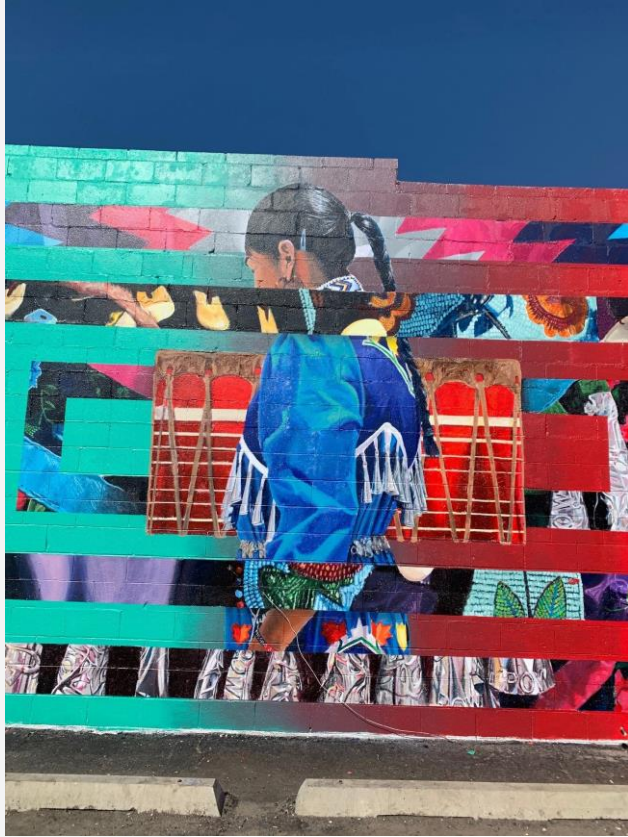

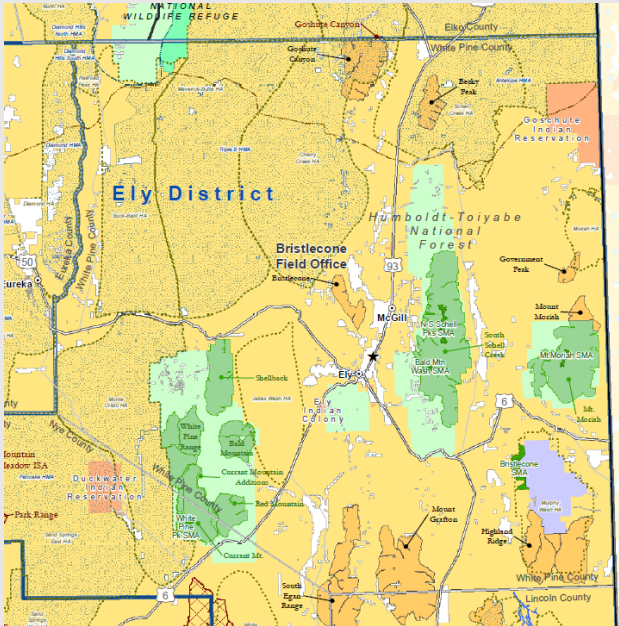
White Pine County Geography and Demographics



- Located in eastern Nevada, south of Elko County and bordered by the State of Utah

White Pine County Land Use and Transport Infrastructure



- White Pine County land base is administered by:
 - Bureau of Land Management administers 77%
 - National Park Services administers 1%
 - US Forest Service administers 13%
 - US Fish and Wildlife administers >1%
 - Bureau of Indian Affairs administers 1%
 - State of Nevada administers 2%
 - Local Government administers >1%
 - Private owns 5%

 - Nevada Northern Railroad
 - County Airport
