- **1. CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL** Chair, David Fogerson, State Administrative Agent (SAA) and Vice-Chair, Deputy Chief Billy Samuels, Urban Area Administrator (UAA).
- 2. - 4. NORTHERN AND SOUTHERN CENTERS FOR INDEPENDENT LIVING (Discussion Only) Heather Lafferty, Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion/Access and Function Needs Coordinator (DEI/AFN). Ms. Lafferty will introduce members of the contract team supporting the Northern and Southern Center for Independent Living in developing a disability focused resource for Nevadans with disabilities. The Committee will learn what this partnership can do to support the local jurisdictions to help with messaging for disasters and emergency preparedness, specifically for people with disabilities living independently in Nevada.
- 5. URBAN SEARCH AND RESCUE (USAR) IN NEVADA (Discussion Only) Vice-Chair Billy Samuels, and Chair David Fogerson. The Committee members will be briefed on Nevada Task Force-1 and discuss the status of USAR in other regions of the state with an

emphasis on how the Committee can, if determined to be necessary, support the expansion of training and equipping resources.

CLARK COUNTY IMPACTED PERSONS DATABASE (Discussion Only) Misty Richardson, Clark County Assistant Emergency Manager and Misty Robinson, Southern Nevada Health District, Public Health Preparedness Supervisor. The Committee will be presented with a demonstration of the newly released impacted persons database Clark County has piloted for victim reunification.
