## **NEVADA OPERATIONS CENTER (NVOC) SITREP**

**INCIDENT NAME – LOCATION:** Atmospheric River #03082023-387 (Region 2 – Western Nevada – Carson, Churchill, Douglas, Lyon, Mineral, Storey, Washoe) and (Region 3 – Eastern Nevada – Elko and White Pine County)

TIME OF INCIDENT: 12:00 AM PST on 08MAR23

**INCIDENT DESCRIPTION:** 

A Flood Advisory is in effect across Western Nevada Region 2 until 1:00 PM PST on 12MAR23. Warm temperatures, increasing humidity, and strong southwest winds are arriving in advance of the Atmospheric River in western Nevada on the afternoon of 09MAR2023. Heavy, wet, high elevation snow and efficient spillover rain into Sierra and western Nevada communities is expected. Low snow levels today will rapidly rise overnight into Friday morning near 8, 000 – 9,000 feet. Areas of greatest concern for flooding potential are lower elevation creeks and streams, and localized flooding due to snow berms blocking drainages.

#### **CONDITIONS**

#### **CURRENT SITATION** (as of 4:00 PM on 09MAR23)

The Atmospheric River has arrived in western Nevada. Several Counties in western and eastern Nevada are preparing for potential flooding. Carson River near Gardnerville is forecast to enter monitoring stage at 12 feet between Friday and Saturday and could potentially hit flood stage at 14 feet Saturday morning and not recede below monitoring stage until later Saturday. Carson River near Carson City is expected to hit monitoring stage between Friday and Saturday and recede sometime Sunday, never reaching the flood stage of 10 feet.
